Background of the Organization:

Vishwas Sansthan, established in 1996-1997, is a society incorporated under the Indian Societies Registration Act 1860 (registration No. 3306–1998-99 granted by Registrar of Societies, Firms & Chits, Lucknow). The organization is managed by a dedicated team of social activists and volunteers, aiming to address the socio-economic developmental needs of marginalized communities, particularly in rural areas. Vishwas Sansthan has implemented various developmental programs funded by government departments, CSR initiatives, and international funding agencies. Their activities encompass women and child welfare, employment-oriented programs for women and youth, healthcare, education, livelihood enhancement, skill development, sustainable agriculture, water and sanitation, research studies, capacity building, and environmental conservation.

Infrastructure Setup and Management Structure: The organization operates with a strong infrastructure for successful implementation of developmental programs. The Society is governed by a board comprising seven members, including office bearers such as the President, Vice President, Secretary/Managing Director, Treasurer, and committee members. The board meets regularly to provide guidance and advisory support. It ensures necessary control, supervision, and direction in matters of recruitment, procurement, financial monitoring, and program management to achieve optimal results.

Human Resources: Vishwas Sansthan has a staff of 19 members, with eight working in administrative roles and 11 engaged in field activities. The organization emphasizes gender equality, with three female staff members in administrative roles and 11 out of the total 19 staff members being female. Additionally, more than 30 volunteers and a team of seven experienced experts support the organization. Collaboration with various departments and agencies facilitates the availability of resource persons, consultants, and trainers.

Financial Management: The organization follows transparent financial management practices. It utilizes a computerized accounting system with the latest version of tally software. Monthly financial statements are prepared to monitor the financial status of each project, and separate books of accounts are maintained for different projects. The accounts are audited by external auditors, and annual reports are generated. Vishwas Sansthan maintains bank accounts in nationalized banks and opens additional accounts as per project requirements. Periodical reports are generated for management information system (MIS) purposes and submitted to project sanctioning authorities.

Rapport and Liaison: Vishwas Sansthan maintains good rapport and liaison with government departments, funding organizations, and grassroots level stakeholders, community leaders, and activists. It receives support from government departments and funding agencies for program implementation. The organization follows a well-defined policy and procedure for procurement, ensuring competitive pricing, quality assessment,

and approval by the procurement committee. Collaboration with co-organizations and recruitment based on selection committee evaluations ensure skilled personnel are appointed for project execution.

organization also distributes educational kits to support students' learning and provides expert-led extra classes in schools, enhancing the quality of education and fostering academic success.

Livelihood: Vishwas Sansthan promotes livelihood enhancement through various initiatives. One such initiative is goat distribution, which helps improve the economic conditions of marginalized communities. The organization also provides startup support to aspiring entrepreneurs, empowering them to establish sustainable livelihoods. Additionally, Vishwas Sansthan promotes the cultivation of medicinal plants, creating opportunities for income generation and sustainable resource management.

Skill Development: Skill development plays a crucial role in empowering individuals and enabling economic independence. Vishwas Sansthan conducts skill development programs in diverse areas, including wooden craft, beautician skills, sewing, food processing, and mobile/home appliances repairing. These programs equip participants with valuable skills that enhance their employability and income-generating potential.

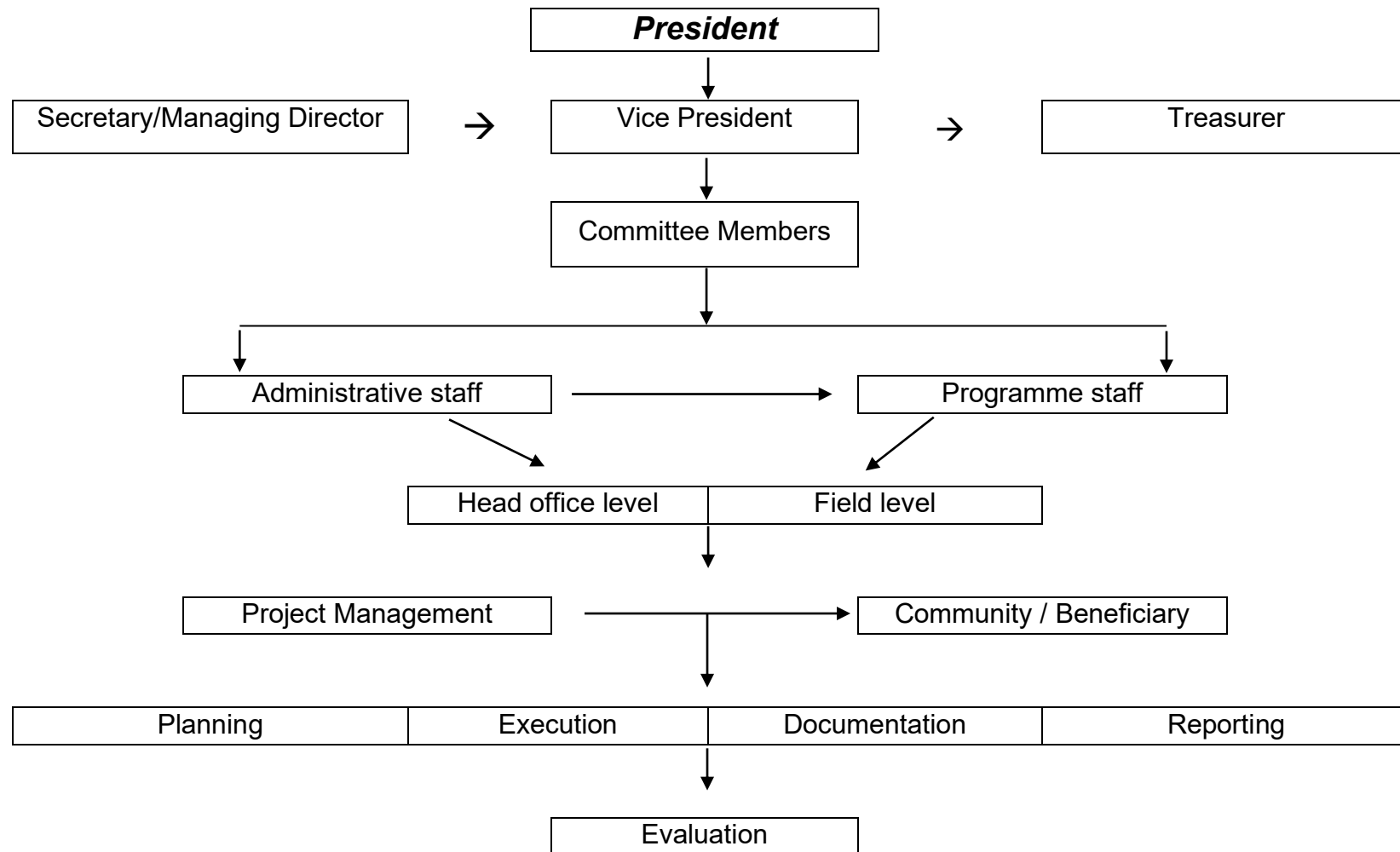

PROFILE OF THE PAST ACTIVITIES AND THEIR IMPACT ON SOCIETY.

- **Development of Model Anganwadi Centers and promotion of health and hygiene awareness among pregnant and lactating mothers(CONCOR, New Delhi):** Vishwas Sansthan has successfully completed the project for the development of Model Anganwadi Centers and promotion of health and hygiene awareness among pregnant and lactating mothers in Blocks Karwi and Pahadi of Aspirational District Chitrakoot, Uttar Pradesh. Under the project, selected Anganwadi Centres were renovated with improved infrastructure, including construction and repair works, boundary walls, electrification, installation of solar-powered equipment, grills, and ventilated windows to create a safe and child-friendly learning environment. Child-friendly toilets, attractive educational wall paintings, slogans, and learning spaces were developed. Essential furniture, teaching-learning materials (TLM), toys, air mattresses, dining tables, and other joyful learning resources were provided to enhance early childhood care and education. Safe drinking water facilities were established to improve hygiene and sanitation. Regular health camps and awareness sessions on maternal health, nutrition, hygiene, and child care were organized for pregnant and lactating mothers. Continuous monitoring and evaluation ensured quality implementation and effective utilization of project resources. The project has significantly strengthened Anganwadi infrastructure, improved service delivery, and created a healthier, safer, and more stimulating environment for young children and their mothers.

Key Impact of the Project

- Strengthened the infrastructure of Anganwadi Centres by creating safe, clean, child-friendly, and inclusive learning environments.
- Improved access to quality Early Childhood Care and Education (ECCE) through the provision of furniture, Teaching Learning Materials (TLM), toys, and joyful learning resources.
- Enhanced sanitation and hygiene standards with the construction/renovation of child-friendly toilets and safe drinking water facilities.
- Ensured uninterrupted basic amenities through electrification and installation of solar-powered systems, making the centres more functional and environmentally sustainable.
- Increased awareness among pregnant and lactating mothers on maternal health, nutrition, hygiene, breastfeeding, immunization, and child care practices.
- Improved health-seeking behaviour through the organization of regular health camps, facilitating early identification and referral of health issues.
- Created a safer and more secure environment for children through boundary

walls, grills, and improved ventilation.

- Enhanced attendance and participation of children at Anganwadi Centres by providing an attractive, stimulating, and child-friendly atmosphere.
- Strengthened community ownership and engagement by involving Anganwadi Workers, mothers, Village Health Sanitation and Nutrition Committees (VHSNCs), and local stakeholders.
- Contributed to better health, nutrition, safety, and overall development outcomes for children under six years of age, pregnant women, and lactating mothers in the project area.
- **Promotion of Health Care & Nutrition with Special Treatment Support to TB Patients (DFCCIL)**: Vishwas Sansthan successfully completed the project on **Promotion of Health Care & Nutrition with Special Treatment Support to TB Patients** in Raebareli district, Uttar Pradesh. The project focused on improving awareness, nutrition, treatment adherence, and overall health outcomes of tuberculosis (TB) patients. Extensive Information, Education and Communication (IEC) activities, including public meetings, awareness campaigns, and distribution of leaflets and pamphlets, were conducted to enhance community awareness about TB prevention, early diagnosis, treatment, and stigma reduction. Monthly nutrition kits were provided to each registered beneficiary for a period of six months to improve their nutritional status and support recovery. Regular follow-up visits and counselling were carried out to monitor patients' health, encourage treatment compliance, and facilitate timely referrals whenever required. Continuous monitoring ensured effective implementation of project activities and contributed to improved health and well-being of TB patients.

Key Impact of the Project

- Increased community awareness regarding tuberculosis, its prevention, symptoms, diagnosis, and treatment through IEC campaigns and public meetings.
- Improved nutritional status of TB patients by providing monthly nutrition kits for six consecutive months.
- Enhanced treatment adherence through regular follow-up, counselling, and continuous support to beneficiaries.
- Contributed to better recovery outcomes by combining nutritional support with timely health monitoring.
- Reduced stigma associated with tuberculosis by promoting awareness and community participation.
- Strengthened coordination between the community, health workers, and government health services for improved TB care.

- Encouraged early diagnosis and timely treatment, helping to reduce the risk of disease transmission.
- Improved the quality of life of TB patients by addressing both their medical and nutritional needs through a comprehensive care approach.
- **Health & Hygiene Programme and Nutrition Support Project(RaiTel):**
Vishwas Sansthan successfully completed the **Health & Hygiene Programme and Nutrition Support Project** in the villages surrounding the Modern Rail Coach Factory, Lalganj, Raebareli. The project aimed to improve the health and nutritional status of pregnant women, lactating mothers, adolescent girls, and other vulnerable community members. Beneficiaries were identified in coordination with ASHA Workers, Anganwadi Workers, and Community Health Centres (CHCs). Regular monthly meetings were organized at Anganwadi Centres to provide counselling on maternal health, nutrition, breastfeeding, hygiene, immunization, and childcare practices. Youth healthcare volunteers were selected and trained to support community awareness activities. IEC campaigns, including distribution of leaflets and wall paintings with health messages, helped increase awareness on health and hygiene. Health camps with free medical check-ups were organized, focusing on personal health care, vaccination, hygiene, anaemia, malnutrition, and disease prevention. Nutrition kits were distributed to pregnant and lactating mothers, anaemic and malnourished women, and adolescent girls to improve their nutritional well-being. Teaching Learning Material (TLM) kits were also provided to Anganwadi Centres to strengthen early childhood education and create a child-friendly learning environment.

Key Impact of The Project

- Improved nutritional status of pregnant women, lactating mothers, anaemic women, malnourished women, and adolescent girls through the distribution of nutrition kits.
- Increased awareness on maternal health, nutrition, breastfeeding, immunization, hygiene, and disease prevention through regular counselling sessions and IEC activities.
- Strengthened community participation through active involvement of ASHA Workers, Anganwadi Workers, CHCs, and trained youth healthcare volunteers.
- Enhanced access to preventive healthcare services through free health camps and regular health check-ups.
- Promoted early identification and referral of high-risk pregnancies, anaemia, and malnutrition cases.

- Improved health-seeking behaviour among women and families through continuous awareness and follow-up.
- Strengthened Anganwadi Centres by providing Teaching Learning Material (TLM) kits to support quality Early Childhood Care and Education (ECCE).
- Created a healthier and more informed community by encouraging safe hygiene practices, vaccination, and proper nutrition.
- Contributed to the overall improvement of maternal and child health outcomes in the project villages.
- **Health & Education Project (Funding Agency: Oil & Natural Gas Corporation Limited):** The Health & Education Project implemented by Vishwas Sansthan in collaboration with Oil & Natural Gas Corporation Limited targeted 4,000 individuals in 20 villages of District Raebareli. The project aimed to address the challenges of school dropouts and promote education among the local communities. Several initiatives were undertaken to achieve this goal.

The project provided school dresses and educational kits to motivate students and parents, thereby encouraging them to prioritize education. Additionally, awareness generation activities through Information, Education, and Communication (IEC) methods were conducted to educate the community about the importance of education and the risks associated with dropout rates.

Health camps were organized to offer healthcare services at the doorstep of the beneficiaries. These camps provided medical check-ups, counselling, and guidance on maintaining good health. Meetings with villagers were held to provide counselling and motivation, creating an environment conducive to educational pursuits. As a result of these efforts, there was a significant reduction in school dropouts, ensuring a brighter future for the children in the targeted communities.

The key impacts have been the reduction in school dropouts, thanks to the Health & Education Project funded by Oil & Natural Gas Corporation Limited. By providing support and resources such as school dress and educational kits, students and parents have been motivated to prioritize education. The project's awareness generation activities have also contributed to a better understanding of the importance of education in the community.

- **Installation of 1,000 Solar Street Lights (Funding Agency: State Bank of India):** In collaboration with State Bank of India, Vishwas Sansthan implemented a project to install 1,000 solar street lights in all villages of District Raebareli. This initiative aimed to improve the lighting infrastructure, benefiting a wide range of

individuals, including students, poor communities, and public places.

The installation of solar street lights addressed the issue of inadequate lighting in remote areas, ensuring safer and well-illuminated surroundings. Students were able to study during evening hours, enhancing their educational opportunities. Moreover, public spaces became more accessible and secure, fostering community engagement and overall well-being. This project had a positive impact on the lives of the residents, promoting a sense of safety and improving the quality of life in the targeted areas.

The installation of 1000 solar street lights by State Bank of India in District Raebareli has had a significant impact on the society. One key impact is the enhanced safety and security in the villages. The presence of well-lit public places has deterred criminal activities and accidents, providing a sense of security to the residents. The illuminated streets have created a safer environment for individuals to move around during the evenings, promoting a greater sense of community well-being. - **Installation of 100 Solar Street Lights (Funding Agency: UCO Bank):**

The primary objective was to address the lighting needs of the community and improve the living conditions of residents, particularly those belonging to economically disadvantaged backgrounds.

- **Health Care Awareness Project (Funding Agency: Bharat Petroleum Corporation Ltd.):** Through the Health Care Awareness Project, supported by Bharat Petroleum Corporation Ltd., Vishwas Sansthan targeted 200 adolescent girls and women in 20 villages across two blocks of Raebareli.
